SECTION 1

Purpose

This Privacy Policy describes how DGTEnergy processes personal data in connection with access to and interaction with its website, decentralized application (DApp), and associated protocol systems.

ITS PURPOSE IS TO:

- ensure transparency in data processing
- define how personal data is handled
- align with applicable data protection regulations, including GDPR

SECTION 2

Scope

THIS POLICY APPLIES TO:

- all users interacting with DGTEnergy systems
- website and DApp usage
- wallet-based interactions
- compliance-related processes

SECTION 3

Data Collected

DGTEnergy may process the following types of data:

3.1 Technical and Usage Data

- wallet addresses (pseudonymous identifiers)
- transaction data
- interaction logs
- device and browser information

3.2 Compliance and Verification Data

- identity verification status
- KYC approval status
- compliance signals and risk indicators

DGTEnergy does not directly collect or store identity documents.

SECTION 4

Identity Verification (KYC)

Identity verification is conducted through third-party providers.

DGTENERGY:

- does not directly collect identity documents
- does not store personal identification files
- receives only verification status and compliance signals

Additional verification may be required at any time based on compliance requirements.

SECTION 5

Purpose of Data Processing

PERSONAL DATA IS PROCESSED STRICTLY FOR:

- compliance and regulatory requirements
- identity verification and eligibility validation
- platform access control
- fraud prevention and security monitoring
- system integrity and operational protection

DGTEnergy does not use personal data for marketing or financial profiling.

SECTION 6

Legal Basis for Processing

DGTENERGY PROCESSES PERSONAL DATA BASED ON:

- legal obligations
- legitimate interests (security, compliance, fraud prevention)
- user consent, where applicable

SECTION 7

Continuous Compliance Monitoring

PERSONAL DATA MAY BE PROCESSED ON AN ONGOING BASIS TO SUPPORT:

- continuous compliance monitoring
- eligibility verification
- risk assessment

Compliance status may change over time and affect access to the platform.

SECTION 8

No Financial Profiling

DGTENERGY DOES NOT PERFORM:

- financial profiling
- investment analysis
- automated decision-making related to financial behavior

All data processing is limited to compliance, security, and operational purposes.

SECTION 9

Data Sharing and Third Parties

DGTENERGY MAY RELY ON THIRD-PARTY PROVIDERS FOR:

- identity verification (KYC)
- AML monitoring
- sanctions screening

DGTENERGY:

- does not control third-party systems
- is not responsible for their independent data practices

Data shared with third parties is limited to what is necessary for compliance purposes.

SECTION 10

International Data Transfers

PERSONAL DATA MAY BE PROCESSED ACROSS MULTIPLE JURISDICTIONS DEPENDING ON:

- operational structure
- service providers
- regulatory requirements

Users acknowledge that data may be transferred internationally.

SECTION 11

Data Retention

PERSONAL DATA IS RETAINED ONLY FOR AS LONG AS NECESSARY TO:

- fulfill legal and compliance obligations
- maintain system security
- support operational integrity

Retention periods may vary depending on regulatory requirements.

SECTION 12

Security Measures

- DGTENERGY APPLIES APPROPRIATE TECHNICAL AND ORGANIZATIONAL MEASURES TO:
- protect data integrity
 - prevent unauthorized access
 - reduce risk of data breaches

However, no system can guarantee absolute security.

SECTION 13

User Responsibilities

USERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- ensuring accuracy of provided information
- maintaining security of their wallets and devices
- complying with applicable laws and regulations

DGTEnergy is not responsible for user-side security failures.

SECTION 14

System Availability and Limitations

DGTENERGY DOES NOT GUARANTEE:

- uninterrupted availability of data systems
- continuous operation of third-party providers
- error-free processing at all times

Service disruptions may occur.

SECTION 15

User Rights

- DEPENDING ON APPLICABLE LAW, USERS MAY HAVE RIGHTS INCLUDING:
- access to their data
 - correction of inaccurate data
 - restriction of processing
 - data deletion (where legally applicable)

Requests may be subject to regulatory limitations.

No Financial or Advisory Use

PERSONAL DATA IS NOT USED FOR:

- financial decision-making
- investment recommendations
- behavioral profiling for economic purposes

DGTEnergy does not provide financial or advisory services.

SECTION 17

Relationship with Other Documents
